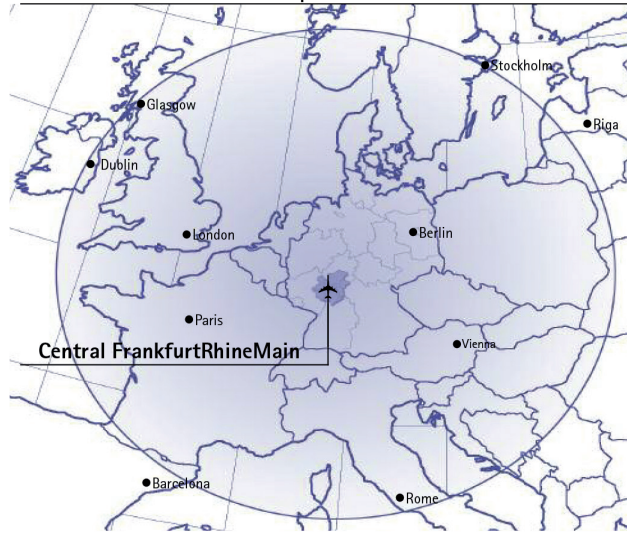

FrankfurtRhineMain

In the RhineMain region 7.9 % of the German gross value is generated. The Hessian part of the region realises a staggering 78 % of the gross domestic product of the federal state of Hessian. These numbers emphasise the status of FrankfurtRhineMain as – according to European standards – one of the most important metropolitan areas of Germany.

There is also no lack of international flair: four European institutions are based in the region. More than 2,500 companies from China and the United States alone have settled here. This is not least due to the excellent infrastructure of the region. At 12 international schools, students can obtain an internationally accredited degree. With over 1,300 flight movements a day, Frankfurt International Airport contributes much to the outstanding accessibility of the metropolitan area for both business travellers and tourists. Ideal conditions, therefore, for businessmen and commuters.

On top of that, FrankfurtRhineMain offers a number of cultural sites, national and international museums and tourist attractions which are visited by almost 13 million people each year.

Museums: German Leather Museum (shows using Leather handicrafts worldwide and in everyday life), Offenbach / Main Gutenberg Museum (one of the oldest printing and writing museums in the world), Mainz Senckenberg Natural History (largest natural history museum in Germany, biology and geology exhibits) Städel (one of Germany's most important art museums), Frankfurt / Main
Architectural Landmarks: Schloss Johannisburg (served until 1803 as a second residence of the archbishops of Mainz and Elector), Aschaffenburg Pompejanum (ideal replica of a Roman villa), Aschaffenburg Mathildenhöhe (most valuable preserved Jugendstil ensemble in Germany), Darmstadt Philippsruhe Castle (City Museum; art exhibitions), Hanau Dom & Skyline (observation deck Main Tower), Frankfurt / Main Einhardbasilika (one of the most significant churches of the Carolingian era in Germany), Seligenstadt Cathedral (one of the most perfect creations of late Romanesque architecture), Limburg Cathedral and St. Stephen's Church (choir with Chagall windows), Mainz Dom, Heiliger Sand (oldest preserved local Jewish cemetery in Europe), Worms

UNESCO World Heritage: Grube Messel (disused oil shale opencast; Fund of outstanding preserved fossil) | Lorsch Abbey (former Benedictine abbey, to the High Middle Ages, a power, humanities and cultural) | Limes | Upper Middle Rhine Valley (senior monuments; epitome of Rhine romance) | The Golden Bull (important law of the Holy Roman Empire; regulates election and coronation of the Roman-German kings)

UNESCO Geopark: Bergstraße-Odenwald (size of 3,500 km²), Darmstadt
